Julia Graziano will offer us a lecture on her quilting journey. Julia is well known to our guild as well as a member and has been responsible for quilting many of the guild's quilt show quilts. She began quilting by taking a six week course at OCC and has been hooked ever since.

April 9, 2019

Alice Gant will offer a lecture on a technique of her own design called "neo-reverse appliqué". Her long-term project is to make banners about influential and interesting individuals, some who perhaps deserve to be known better.

May 14, 2019

Susan Soto will offer us a lecture during the meeting with a workshop in the afternoon. When Susan came upon her grandfather's kimono and obi with his kamon (family crest) on it she knew she wanted to begin sewing in the traditional Japanese style. She will share how she developed her work with Japanese fabrics and techniques. Her workshop will be on Sashiko/Boro stitching technique and how to incorporate this within quilts. Workshop fee: \$30 plus there will be a kit fee of \$15 per person- total cost= \$45.
